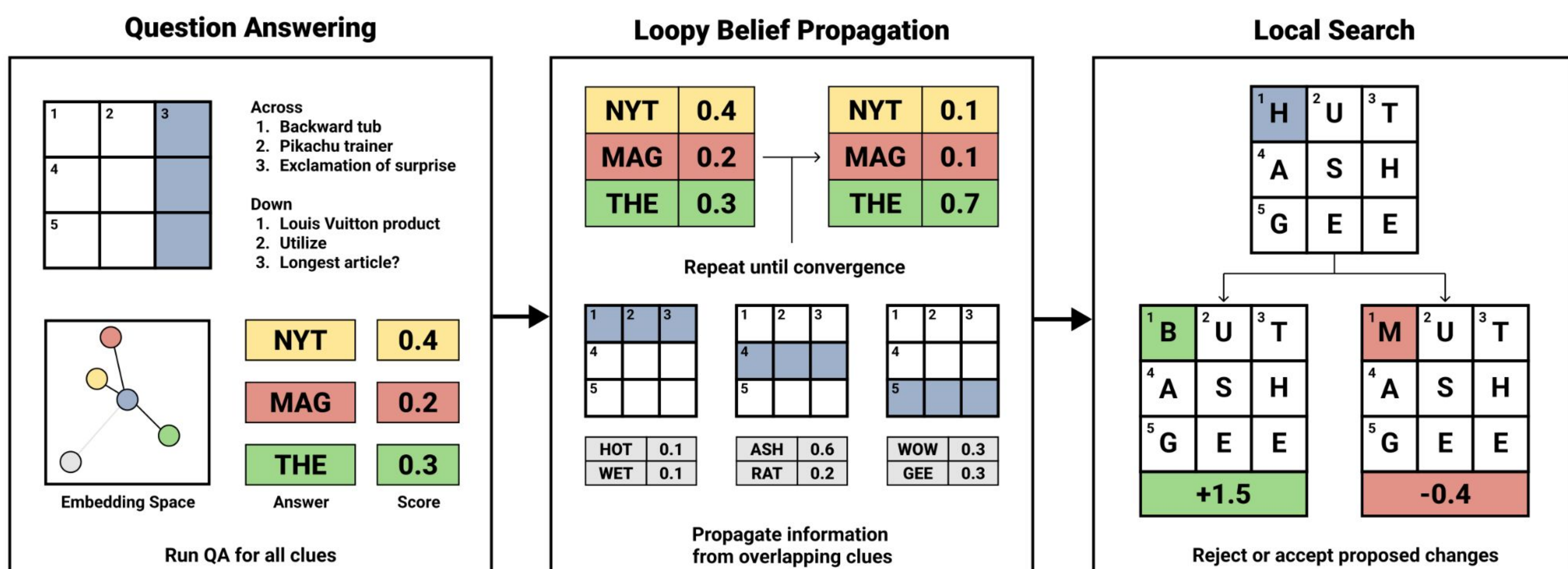

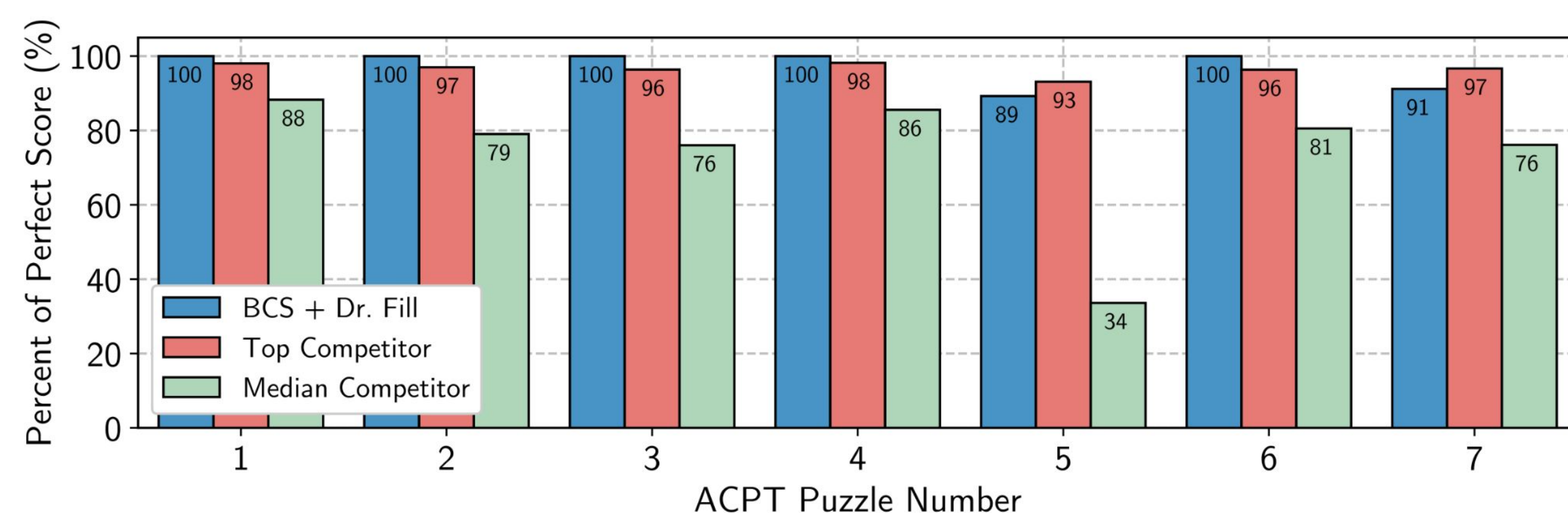
System Overview



- Question Answering: Use a neural QA model to generate answer probabilities for each clue
- Belief Propagation: Refine answer probabilities by reasoning over crossing answers
- Local Search: Flip and rescore individual characters in the puzzle
